Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient Program

North Central Health Care offers a state-certified outpatient clinic that provides a Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient program available to adults 18 and older who reside in Marathon, Langlade and Lincoln counties.

Each person's treatment and recovery is unique to their situation, which is why the Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient program offers a multi-disciplinary approach in treating those with a chemical dependency.

Specialized Support & Treatment Solutions

Every individual struggling with addiction has unique needs – whether that addiction is to alcohol or other drugs. Some individuals need a more structured and intensive recovery program and require a significant amount of support while they are obtaining treatment. The Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient program provides that structure and increased support while integrating participants back into their daily life.



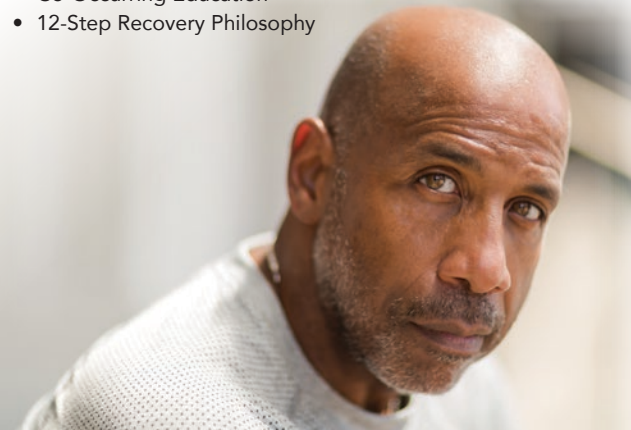
Intensive Treatment for Those Who Need It

The Intensive Outpatient program provides a group setting for individuals struggling with addiction – whether that addiction is to alcohol or other drugs. The program is designed for those who need more intensive substance abuse treatment than typical outpatient services, but do not require the level of care provided in the Day Treatment program.

Each group session lasts 2 hours, meets 3 times per week and runs 8 weeks in length. Individual sessions may also be scheduled.

The Intensive Outpatient program utilizes interventions and techniques which may include:

- Group Therapy
- Individual Therapy
- Rational-Emotive Behavioral Therapy (REBT)
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT)
- Substance Abuse Education (Alcohol and Other Drugs)
- Co-Occurring Education
- 12-Step Recovery Philosophy



A Team Approach

All individuals are treated by a team of skilled professionals trained in multiple disciplines. This team works together to review and assess the individual's progress and to adjust the individual care plan as needed. **After successful completion of the Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient program, each client is set up with appropriate aftercare treatment with a substance abuse counselor as well as an introduction to the recovery community.**

Building A Support Network

North Central Health Care offers supportive services for family members and significant others of Substance Abuse Day Treatment individuals. Counseling and therapy options offered by a professional team of providers helps friends and family develop a better understanding of their loved ones addiction, treatment and life after treatment. Options may include individual and group therapy.



The Intensive Outpatient program is operated at North Central Health Care and is available for all residents in Marathon, Langlade and Lincoln counties.
