Enrich the Life of a Resident

Volunteers play a critical role in improving the quality of life for many of our residents in both Wausau and Merrill. With a wide variety of opportunities available, our volunteers are sure to find something that is both fun and meaningful. **Frequent volunteer opportunities include:**

Gift Shop: Provide residents the ability to purchase small gifts, cards and snack items.

Activity Volunteer: Assist residents to and from activities prepared by the life enrichment team.

On-site Volunteers assist with events like Bingo, Church Services and more!

Off-site Volunteers Assist with events like Casino Trips, Movies, Community Outings and more!

The Fashion Boutique is a donation closet. Volunteers assist our residents in selecting appropriate clothing items, sorting and restocking the boutique.

Ride-Alongs: Provide companionship to residents and comfort to familiy members while helping residents navigate appointments (ride with residents to appointments, assist with getting residents to the correct office/department, wait in lobby during appointments)

Clerical Assistance: Volunteers are needed to assist with small clerical duties.

Special Friends: Socialize and/or play games with a resident. Some of our residents have little or no family and enjoy someone to visit with them. Days and times are flexible and can be set up to accommodate your schedule.
