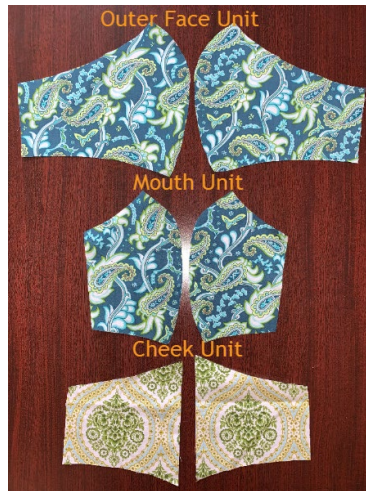


GO! Olson Face Mask

Finished Size: 6" x 9"

You will need the following pieces to make one mask.



Sewing: Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Outer Face Unit

With right sides together, sew 1/4" seam along the curved edge. Lay aside. (Figure 1)

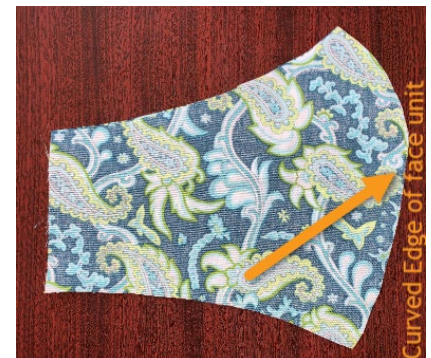

Mouth Unit

1. Fold the straight edge of the mouth piece toward the wrong side 1/4" press and stitch along this fold, using a scant 1/4" seam. Repeat on the opposite mouth piece. (Figure 2)

Placing right sides together, sew 1/4" seam along the curved edge. (Figure 3)

Cheek Unit

2. Fold the long side of the cheek piece toward the wrong side 1/4". Press and stitch down using a scant 1/4" seam. Repeat on the opposite cheek piece. (Figure 4)

Layout

3. Open the face unit with right side facing you. *Deep curve should be at the top.
4. Lay the mouth unit on top of the face unit, right sides together and align seam. (Figure 5)
5. Nest seams and pin in place at top and bottom.
6. Lay unit in front of you and align cheek pieces on top of the face unit with folded edges facing up. (Figure 6)
7. Pin in place, making sure the cheek pieces are overlapping the mouth unit about 1".
8. Stitch all the way around the face mask using 1/4" seam.

Finish

9. Turn mask right side out by pulling the mask through one of the folds.
10. Push out your corners.
11. Use a thin elastic hair tie to slip over the side of the face mask (Figure 7) and fold it about 1/2" toward the center. Shorten your stitch length and stitch in place. Repeat on the other side. (Figure 8)

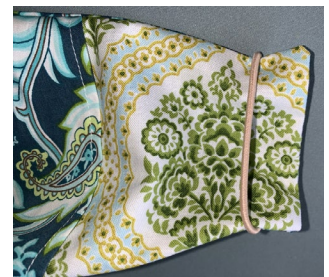
