


Safety Zone Changes & Antigen Test Kits:

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW!

Recently, Infection Prevention has been working on updates to SafetyZone on the Employee Form regarding Covid-19 tests and results. On the Employee Form, the following

changes were made to allow staff to quickly identify if they tested positive for Covid-19 and a place to upload a photo of an antigen test result.



After filling required info and checking illness as the reason for the occurrence, a series of additional questions appear:

ANTIGEN TEST KITS

Antigen test kits will be available in Nursing Homes, Behavioral Health, and Residential programs for staff to use for self-testing. Please talk with your manager for the secure location of the test kits in your program area. Additional test kits will be stored in the Lab on the Wausau Campus.
