WEEKLY CONNECTION WITH GARY OLSEN

This week Open Enrollment begins, which gives NCHC employees the opportunity to review benefit options and make changes for the following calendar year. This year's Open Enrollment runs from October 23rd to November 3rd. During this time frame, eligible employees will need to select the type of health insurance coverage they would like. For those declining coverage, you will still need to participate in the Open Enrollment online process. A listing of the dates for the Open Enrollment in-person sessions are included on page 2. Lynn Wengelski from Human Resources will be hosting several in-person sessions over the next two weeks to assist employees and answer questions. If

you cannot attend the in-person sessions, we also have a video on our website that walks you through the benefits for 2024.

Along with enrolling or declining, Open Enrollment is also the time to make any changes to other NCHC insurance coverage like dental, vision insurance, and HSA contributions. Because we follow our Core Value of Continuous Improvement, we are always looking for ways to make our benefits affordable. Due to the potential increases from the Aspirus network we belonged to for our health insurance coverage, we made the decision to switch carriers for 2024 and go with Anthem. Lynn will have information regarding the new carrier at the Open Enrollment sessions. The health plan structures will stay the same, with the only change being to our in-network providers. The 2024 listing of providers is larger than it was under our 2023 cover-

Because our NCHC Health Plan is a self-funded plan, meaning NCHC pays all the claim costs, we are encouraging employees covered by our plan to utilize the Employee Health & Wellness Center's on-site clinic at the Wausau Campus as much as possible. Some services you may utilize at the on-site clinic are:

- Annual physicals
- Chronic condition support (hypertension, diabetes, asthma, anxiety, depression, thyroid disorders and prescriptions)
- Health monitoring (blood pressure, cholesterol, blood sugar, weight management, routine lab test and gynecological concerns)
- Common health issues (colds, sore throat, earaches, influenza, sinus infection, stomach disorders, nausea, skin problems, rashes, bug bites, minor wounds, suturing, strains, sprains, urinary tract infections),
- Wellness care (health screening, prevention education, general fitness assessment, goal setting and routine wellness advice)
- Lab services and procedures (rapid strep test, urine dip stick, flu screens and pregnancy tests)
- Well child visits (ages 16 years old and up.
- Acute care visits for ages 18 months and up).

These services are available for those employees who are on NCHC's Health Plan, along with their spouse and children who are on the plan. By utilizing the on-site clinic, you can save yourself and the health insurance plan money. This is an easy way to help us control insurance costs that assists us in keeping premiums lower for the future.

Employee Performance Evaluation System

Overview





North Central Health Care is dedicated to providing employees with prompt and accurate feedback about their performance. The goal of the Performance Evaluation System is to provide guidance and feedback to employees so they can be as productive and successful on the job as possible.

Annual Performance Evaluation Period: October – December



STEP 1: Employee Self-Appraisal October 1st - 15th

Log into UKG and complete your online self-appraisal.

STEP 2: Manager Assessment Oct. 15th - Dec. 15th

Managers will log into UKG and complete the online appraisal of your performance. You will be evaluated on the 6 competencies shown to the right.



STEP 3: In-Person Review Meeting October 15th - December 15th

Managers will meet with you to review your performance. SMART Goals for 2024 will be developed and reviewed.

What will employees be evaluated on?

6 Competencies

- Communication
- Core Values
- Job Knowledge
- Person-Centered Service
- Quality of Work
- Teamwork & Fostering a Positive **Work Environment**

Employee's pay for performance amount will be based on their individual Employee Performance **Evaluation. All Performance-Based increases are** effective annually in March.

IMPORTANT: If you have not completed your required UKG learning modules by Dec. 31, you will not be eligible for a performance-based pay increase.

Employees less than 0.3 FTE or occasional status will <u>not</u> be assigned a Performance Evaluation through UKG.







WAUSAU CAMPUS PARKING CHANGES



THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO ALL NCHC WAUSAU CAMPUS EMPLOYEES

NCHC Outpatient Services has moved into their new location at Suite A. Due to increased traffic of Outpatient Visitors, Aquatic Visitors and MVCC visitors:

EMPLOYEES ARE PROHIBITED FROM PARKING IN LOTS A, B, & C from 7 am to 6 pm, Monday - Friday. All NCHC employees must park in lot D, E, H, or J (See map below) entering at 1100 Lake View Drive, M-F, 7 am - 6 pm. There will be no parking for employees entering 2400 Marshall Street. Below you will find a full Wausau Campus Map with all departments listed, as well as a specific Employee Parking Map.

**Please note, Lot J will be opening very soon. Do not park in Lot J until announced.







North Central Health Care **2023 EMPLOYEE VACCINATION PROGRAM**

ALL Employees Must Complete by Dec. 4

- Make an appointment and get your Flu and/or Covid vaccinations*.
- Complete the required forms.
- Return your forms to NCHC Employee Health.

*Your manager will deliver all required forms and instructions directly to you at work. Employees who work with vulnerable elderly populations will have requirements for Influenza and Covid vaccinations. All other employees will have requirements for Influenza vaccination only. Employees who do not complete these steps by Dec. 4 will be removed from the schedule.





Skip the Clinic! If you work in a Direct Car Program, talk with your manager about how to get your vaccination(s) from a trained nurse vaccinator right in your department!

Make An Appointment to Get Make An Appointment to Get Your Vaccination Outside NCHC! You can get vecinations (at your expense) at the Employee Health & Wellness Center (must be covered by an NCHC Health plan) a Primary Care Clinic of your choice, or at a Community Pharmacy. Remember to get proof of vaccination from the provider!

FOLLOW-UP: EMPLOYEE VACCINATION CLINICS HAVE BEGUN!

Thank you to all those who have signed up to get vaccinated or who have turned in forms to meet the Employee Vaccination Program requirements. As a reminder, only employees who work in nursing homes, food services, housekeeping, and transportation are offered the Covid vaccine at our Employee Vaccination Clinics. We have received many inquiries at the clinics regarding this.

An Update on Covid Vaccine Availability

Influenza vaccines have been readily available, however, unfortunately, there has been a delay in shipment of Covid vaccines across the country. While we do have some Covid vaccines on hand, our Employee Vaccination Clinics may not have enough to provide to all the employees who have signed up over the next 2 weeks. We may need to reschedule some Covid shot appointments due to the shortage. We anticipate the delivery of the remainder Covid vaccines throughout the month of October, however, we are only receiving partial batches each week or two.

We encourage all those who have signed up for the flu/Covid shots to keep your appointment. We will get you your Covid vaccine or let you know if you need to reschedule your Covid vaccine appointment. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and assure you that our Pharmacy team is working hard to make sure we have what we need to get our employees and residents vaccinated.


