In the first half of 2025, employee referrals became a key contributor to our hiring success by helping us bring in more new team members than ever through personal connections and trusted recommendations.

Compared to the end of 2024, when only 4% of new hires came from referrals, we've now seen that number grow to 20% which is a fivefold increase!

This change didn't happen by accident. It happened because you, our team members, believing in the work we do and the people we do it with. When you refer someone to NCHC, you're showing confidence in our mission and inviting others to be part of something meaningful.

- Your recruit must work for NCHC for 90 days.
- You and your recruit must be in good standing with no disciplinary actions such as written warnings for attendance or other performance.*
